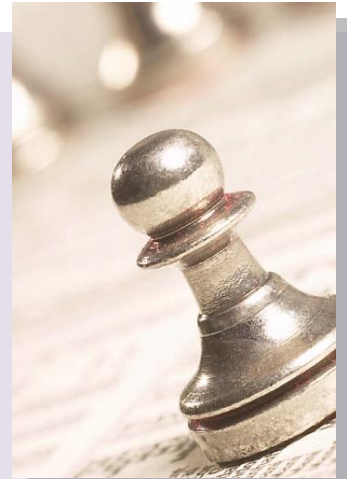


Program Management Professional (PgMP®)
