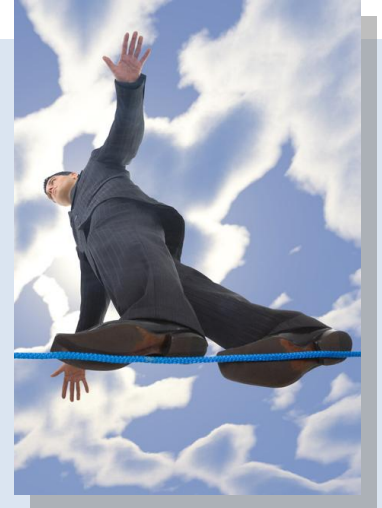


# Risk Management Professional (RMP®)
